If you are holding this program in your hands it means one thing.... You made it! You are at the world infamous Gathering of the Juggalos, whether you came all the way from the Fiji Islands or from the depths of the Detroit underworld, you're standing at the brink of a truly devastating experience that you can tell your momma's momma about, bitch boy. Hold on to your wig 'cause with all the shit that is awaiting you it's about to be blown up like the Hornswagglin' Hillbilly's bathroom.

Before we go over all the different things there are to do at the Gathering we must first go over a few very important details.

Wristbands – When you give up your ticket on the way into the Novi Expo Hall you will be given a wristband. Do not take it off. This wristband is your pass to get in and out of the Novi Expo Center as you please. This wristband is good for both Friday and Saturday, so when you leave Friday night do not take it off! If you are seen inside the Novi Expo Center without a wristband on (or with one that has been stretched out of shape) you will be escorted out just as if you had sneaked in. If you damage a wristband in some way bring the whole wristband to the box office and it might be replaced. Lost wristbands will not be replaced.

Cameras – You may bring in cameras all that you like, but no video or audio recorders will be allowed. Those caught inside with these devices will be placed in a room for two minutes and made to lick peanut butter off of Choko's feet. Some areas may be restricted from photography, and if so, you will be notified before entering.

Selling – There is no selling of substantial amounts of ICP merchandise allowed at the Gathering of the Juggalos. This is not the place for storeowners or Internet merchants to bring their wares and set up shop. Any bootleggers caught in a 100-mile radius will be handled in the usual fashion, and will be clownified. Believe me, you don't want to know what that is!

Outdoor Stage Friday Only (8pm - 11pm)

What would a Juggalo convention be without Psychopathic music to mosh to? You will see the return (by demand of the Juggalos) of Psychopathic superstar Myzery as he destroys the crowd... then see Psychopathic homies, Kottonmouth Kings, bring their suburban hip-hop flavor to your ass... and finally, see them killa-ganstas themselves, the real murderin' thugs, the Psychopathic Rydas! Wear your bullet proofs, mudda fuckers!

Blaze, Project Born, Twiztid, and Insane Clown Posse

Outdoor Stage Saturday Only (7:40pm - 11pm)

This will be the grand finale. At the concert's end you are guaranteed to see more shit flying off stage than ever thought possible. No one in sight will be safe. Come witness the birth of Psychopathic's newest member, Blaze Your Dead Homie, as he unleashes the wicked dead shit in his special showcase performance. All contestants who receive perfect scores will get to come back for the Computer Trivia Showdown being held Saturday night (5:45pm - 6:45pm). There, everyone competing will play a final game for a chance at the Grand Prize: a Psychopathic Records leather jacket and your photo appearing for a week on ICP's web site with fat props. The Second Place prize will be a Psychopathic hockey jersey, and the Third Place prize will be a Psychopathic baseball jersey. All this is hosted by none other than Jelly Nuts himself! Come here also to see all episodes of The Shaggy Show, including never-seen-before footage, which will be playing in high quality on a big screen TV for people waiting in line and passersby.

Carnival Games

Carnival Games

Friday and Saturday (all day long)

Note: You may only win once a day per carnival game.

What would the Dark Carnival be if it didn't have carnival games? Test your reflexes, luck, and mental acuity in these games of skill! The games and how they are played are listed below:

Dunk Tanks (2) – Features Slim Anus and a redneck.
Players are given three balls to pitch at a small target from about 30ft away. Success wins you a prize and causes the sap to be dumped in a tank filled with Faygo.

Basketball Hoops (2) – Players are given two chances to sink a basketball at about the three-point line. One basket scored is a small prize, while two baskets is a phat prize.

Pool Tables (2) – Players break four balls with a cue ball. They then attempt to sink whatever balls are left after the break. The only catch is that they must sink the high ball last and every shot must be called. Balls sunk accidentally results

in a loss. Players who are successful win a prize.

Milk Bottle Toss (1) – Players pitch a ball in an attempt to knock a pyramid of bottles off a stand. Those who do so win a prize.

Psycho Karaoke Contest

Outdoor Stage Friday (4pm - 4:45pm) Saturday (12 noon - 12:45pm)

Those who wish to compete in this event must go immediately to the Outdoor Stage to audition as soon as doors open. Only groups of two may enter. They either rap an ICP or a Twiztid song. The audition process will last an hour, with every team being allowed to rap privately in front of a judge. Judges choose the six best teams that then get to compete on the main stage in the Karaoke Contest. One at a time, these six teams hit the stage in front of the crowd and put on their best performance. Instrumental music is provided for this event over a professional sound system, but contestants must choose from the following list of songs to rap to:

ICP - "Chicken Huntin'," "Piggy Pie," "Southwest Voodoo," "Neden Game," "Hokus Pokus," "Bring it On," "Play with Me," "I Want My Shit," "Assassins," and "Fuck the World."

Twiztid - "First Day Out," "Rock the Dead," and "Bury Me Alive."

The Judges will decide the wining team based on accuracy and performance, taking crowd reaction into heavy consideration. The winners from both days win a special Backstage Pass that allows them to go backstage Saturday Night starting at 8pm. Along with chillin' with the stars, they will also get to perform one song with either ICP or Twiztid on stage during their main concert on Saturday night. Yes, you read it correctly!

Costume Contest

Indoor Stage Saturday Only (11:30am - 12 noon)

Come dressed as one of the Joker's Cards... come dressed as space zombie... come dressed as a redneck! Make the most crazy, outlandish, and wild shit you can imagine. Those who wish to compete in this event must be in costume and go immediately to the Indoor Stage as soon as doors open. Contestants will be lined up and a judge will quickly choose the 20 most eye-catching costumes. Those who are chosen proceed to the backstage area where their information will be taken so the MC can properly introduce them on stage. One at a time they will be brought out before the crowd and judges to display their costume. A microphone will be in place should a contestant wish to say something. Once each person has had a chance to hit the stage, the judges will tally their scores and all contestants will be brought back out. The

winners will then be announced. The First Place winner receives three costumes that were used in the movie Big Money Hustlers. Second Place receives \$100, while Third Place receives \$60.

Lingerie Contest

Indoor Stage (18 and older only to compete, ID required)
Saturday Only (4pm - 4:30pm)

Bring your own lingerie (must fully cover private areas). We want hot, sexy freaks in the hottest, sexiest lingerie! Remember, if you are not particularly beautiful, that attitude and/or large titties go a long way in these contests. Those wishing to compete should be at the Indoor Stage at 3:30pm where 20 women will be picked. They will then be escorted back stage to a dressing area with mirrors so that they can prepare themselves. One at a time the contestants will come out on stage in front of the crowd to strut their stuff. Afterwards, all contestants will be lined up and the crowed will applaud for their favorite girls. The top five girls will then come forward for one more final showdown. The winner is the one who receives the loudest applause. The grand prize is a \$500 shopping spree at any of the merchandise booths in the building.



Miss Juggalette Pageant

Indoor Stage

Saturday Only (2pm - 3:30pm)

This is where scantily clad women of seduction show off their bountiful curves. To be crowned Juggalette Queen is not just about having a perfect body. It's also about confidence and charisma. Judges will be taking crowd approval into heavy consideration when scoring, so be creative. Any Juggalette wishing to compete should show up at the Indoor Stage at 1:30pm. Among the girls that show up, 20 will be chosen to compete and will be escorted to the backstage area. Once there, you will be directed as to what you need to do. The Pageant is broken into three rounds:

Personality – Contestants will be introduced, walk across the stage, and then answer a few questions from the MC of the Pageant.

Talent – Contestants will display some sort of talent, such as acting, signing, dancing, kissing, gymnastics, magic, leg splits, poem reading, Faygo guzzling, or whatever you can think of. Music can be provided, or you may bring your own if desired. Anything goes.

Beauty – Oh yes, the swimsuit round, where almost all the flesh is exposed for the viewing pleasure of the audience. Contests simply walk the stage and try to look as sexy as they can. Extra bathing suits are available in the dressing room for those who did not bring one.

Five judges score contestants in each category. The top five then move into the final round where they walk across the stage one last time. The judges score this last round simply on crowd reaction. The winner is determined by who has the most points. The First Place winner receives a Great Milenko Platinum Plaque with Juggalette Queen embossed on it, and is then escorted backstage to meet with a Psychopathic star of her choice and set a time to go on a date. Second Place wins a backstage pass and \$60. Third Place wins \$60.

Tattoo Contest

Indoor Stage Friday Only (3:30pm - 4pm)

Do you have a fresh looking ICP or Twiztid tattoo? Do people always come up to you and say, "That Psychopathic tattoo is the bomb?" Well, enter your tattoo into the Best Tattoo Contest! Competitors should show up at 3:15pm at the Indoor Stage where they will be lead backstage. They will then walk out on center stage, one at a time, before a panel of judges to display their tattoos. Judges will compile their scores, and the top three will be declared the winners. The First Place winner gets a quick course in wrestling so as to become ICP's third partner in a triple tag match against Hollywood Chuck Hogan, Leather Face, and the Masked Negotiator in the main

event of JCW's Friday show. The winner will also get a tattoo of his or her choosing no matter how big or detailed it is (time permitting). Second Place wins a Psychopathic hockey jersey, and Third Place wins a Psychopathic baseball jersey.

The Neden Game

Indoor Stage (18 and older only to compete, ID required)
Friday (6pm - 7pm) (two 30min games)
Saturday (12:30pm - 1:30pm) (two 30min games)

Five eager Juggalos will be chosen from the crowed by the MC to come up on the stage to compete in the Neden Game. Much like the Dating Game, the Juggalos will answer rather interesting questions from the woman they are trying to win a date from, while being hidden from each other's sight by a wall. Psychopathic will be supplying the women; each one will be a certified, super-stacked and bangin' tittie dancer (a.k.a. stripper). Whatever Juggalo is best able to seduce and sweettalk the fine-ass tittie dancer wins a date with her. That date takes place immediately after the Neden Game is over. A limo, dinner, and hotel room are all provided for the winners! Between the two days there will be four shows, thus four winners.

The second prototypes dolls were in the process of being made when Hollywood Records, being pimped by that big butt-fucking mouse (Disney), dropped ICP, so the dolls never came to be. Along with the dolls you get their original ad as well.

Item #13) Hallowicked Clown Collection - These items include the following: Dead Pumpkins tape-this was the tape that was passed out for free in 1994 at the first ever Hallowicked Show at the Majestic Theater in Detroit. Finally, there is a Hallowicked Backstage Pass-this was used during the 1997 4th annual Hallowicked Show at the Ritz in Roseville. MI.

Item #14) Big Money Hustlas Magic Ninja Suit - This is the actual suit worn by the yellow ninja in the movie, Big Money Hustlas. NIGHTLIFE

This is some of the nightlife of Detroit and Novi. We've selected a few places we thought you might be interested in checking out. If they aren't open all night long, they should be open at least till 2am. You can look at the maps on the last page for their general locations, however, you'll probably need a detailed street map to avoid getting hopelessly lost.

Detroit

#1 St. Andrew's Hall - 431 E. Congress, Detroit (313) 961-MELT. Located deep in the heart of Detroit, this club is a favorite amongst everyone from punk rockers, to hip-hoppers, to gang bangers. It's dark, shady atmosphere, along with its vibrating music contributes to a drug-induced effect. Three different floors, three different types of music. The clash is enough to make for a very interesting night.

#2 Magic Stick - 4120 Woodward,
Detroit (313) 833-9700. This alternative club derives its name from its large abundance of pool tables. This is where the hip crowd hangs out. You're likely to see fashionable college students killing time, listening to the many different bands that perform there from one night to the next like a blur. This would be a nice place to take a girlfriend to.

#3 Labyrinth – 1703 Cass Ave., Detroit (313) 438-6153. This is an underground club—literally. It is the basement of a Ramada Hotel in a seedy little area. It is renown for its specialty industrial and hip-hop nights. Sex and drugs go round and round like the many drinks being mixed at the bar. The music thumps to a dark atmosphere, and you can always find a dark corner to get away with just

about anything.

#4 Clark Park - Vernor at Bagley,
Detroit. This is the famous park that
ICP used to chill at during their Inner
City Posse days. Located near the
thriving area of Detroit known as
Mexican Town, this park does not fall
under the tourist area. It is known for
shootings, stabbings, rapes—if you got
the time, there's plenty of crime. This
area's infamous throughout all of
Detroit. It is the equivalent of what
Hell's Kitchen is to New York.

#5 Drive-in Theaters – Ford-Wyoming
1-5, Ford Rd., West of Wyoming,
Dearborn (313) 846-6910 and FordWyoming 6-9, Wyoming, North of Ford
Rd., Dearborn (313) 582-2200. Nothin'
like chillin' in your car, munchin' on
some popcorn, watchin' a late night
movie.

#6 Elmwood Cemetery – 1200
Elmwood St., Detroit (313) 567-3453.
Most people do not realize that the peaceful stream that runs through this historic graveyard once ran thick with blood. History books on Detroit document a 1763 massacre (known as the "Battle of Bloody Run") of British troops led by Ottawa Indian Chief Pontiac that resulted in the deaths of as many as 160 people. Many claim to

have heard distant screams emanating from the cemetery, as if from dying men, late at night.

#7 Plaka Coney Island – 535 Monroe St., Detroit. Located smack in the middle of the biggest tourist attraction Detroit has to offer: Greektown. During the day this area thrives with many tourists and hot babes. During the night, the activity decreases greatly, but this one restaurant stays open 24 hours and offers you good food, not to mention a diversity of characters coming in to dine from all walks of life.

#8 MGM Grand Casino – 1300 John C. Lodge, Detroit (877) 888-2121. This is one of the freshest places to visit if you're old enough (18 and over only). Stepping into the place you will see pimps, hustlers, mack-daddies, players, ballers, all trying to connect with that green and hit that lucky number. Great atmosphere, a devastating buffet, near-naked waitresses, a good place to chill, and it would appear (by experience) that the games are not rigged.

#9 Windsor - Take Jefferson to the tunnel or cross the Ambassador Bridge to cross over to another country: Oh, Canada. #11 Show Girls - 8 Mile & Greenfield, Detroit. You know you've found the real thing when the first thing you see when you walk in is bulletproof glass. This is all nude entertainment at its sleazy best.

#12 Players - 13710 E. Eight Mile Rd., Detroit (313) 371-6970.

More upscale and classy, this topless club caters to a more professional crowd. The girls expect big tips for their big tits. This is a place where you can become lost in the voluptuous atmosphere of beautiful women who are kind and friendly (until the dough runs out).

#13 Brazil – 305 S. Main St., Royal Oak (248) 399-7200. Located right smack dab in more alternative flavor than you can handle, this area of Royal Oak is mad in effect on the weekends, all night long. Plenty of clubs, coffeehouses, and loiterers hanging out all night long, listening to boom boxes, passing illegal substances, and just kickin' it. Here nobody gives a fuck what you look like or who your are, they're too interested in getting high on their own supply. Great place for vampire neden.


