Before you begin to peep out the rest of this program make sure you first go over the very important information below:

The Program – You hold in your hands the official Gathering of the Juggalos 2001 program that will help guide you through all three days. Inside, you will find a map detailing the layout, and a timeline giving you an easy reference tool to see when events take place. You will also find a detailed description of every event that we will have this year. This program is very important to enjoy the Gathering to its maximum level, so take care not to lose it. Additional copies may be purchased at the Information Desk.

Metal Amulets – The metal amulet that you have received upon purchase of your ticket is your life, so don't lose it! This amulet will allow you to get in and out of the SeaGate Convention Centre (during the convention hours) at will, for all three days. You must visibly wear this amulet at all times or you will be immediately escorted out. Furthermore, each of your limbs will be tied to a different horse that will then begin to walk in opposite directions, until slowly and painfully you are pulled apart.

JUGGALOS!!!

What IS NOT Allowed Inside – Smoking. Outside food and beverages of any kind (there are concession stands inside). Tape recorders, video camcorders, or any high-tech looking digital cameras. Weapons, or items that could be used as makeshift weapons. Spray paint or stickers of any kind. Playa hatas or straight up bustas. Large amounts of merchandise – the Gathering is no place for merchants to set up shop. Bootleggers are strictly forbidden inside and out, and will be dealt with by a specialized hit-and-run patrol.

What IS Allowed Inside – Non-digital picture cameras or Polaroids. Skate apparel, such as safety gear, skateboards, or roller blades; but keep in mind that you may only skate in the Skate Park! Backpacks or travel bags. Promotional material to leave in the Juggalo Promotional Booth, such as flyers, CD or tape samplers, photo flats, etc. (But remember, no stickers.) Fat tittie freaks, and crazy fresh costumes and artwork.

Damages – Any damages done to the outside or inside of the SeaGate Convention Centre must be paid for by Psychopathic Records as agreed by contract. For example, if someone spray-painted the outside of the SeaGate Centre, then they may as well be spay-painting our Psychopathic office building, 'cause it will cost us the same to repair the damages either way. So please chill out on any destructive behavior to the building property, and think twice before putting out a secretly smoked cigarette butt on a plush carpet. If any Juggalos observe this type of activity, they should physically inform the perpetrators of how wack they are.

Bag Check – We will have a bag check (for free of course) for anyone who wishes to leave his or her bags or personal items in a safe and secured area. This is perfect for skaters who don't want to lug around all their gear. Just bring your bag or whatever to the area marked Bag Check on the map and they will give you a ticket so you can reclaim your stuff at a later time. If you leave something in the Bag Check area make sure you pick it up before the end of the day, as we are not responsible for stolen goods if left overnight.

Information Desk - Have you lost your program and are having a hard time finding your way around? Or better yet, have you lost your mind and need to know who you are? Do you have a serious complaint or compliment? Do you need to know where the bathroom is or what the time it is in London? Well all your questions will be answered immediately by the friendly and armed people at the Information Desk. If you have a problem of any kind, stop by for immediate help. So don't worry, and whatever you do, don't panic! Also at the Information Desk are full credit card services. Here you can buy Psychopathic Gift Certificates using your plastic. These are good at all Psychopathic merchandise booths for all three days. Also, if extra money is needed outside, for food, hotel, etc., the SeaGate Centre has plenty of ATMs available for those emergency cash runs.

EVENTS

Every event is free of charge, covered by the one-time cost of your ticket. Your only additional costs come from food and merchandise that you may want to buy (and, of course, your hotel room). Each event is categorized by title, then location (which you can find on the map in this program), then day(s) and time(s) the event is being run, and finally web site(s), if any. Note that Hall C will be completely closed Friday and Saturday starting at 7pm, and Sunday starting at 6pm.

All of the items for auction have been taken from Psychopathic Records' archives or even donated from the personal collections of employees and artists. The Auction will be run just as it was last year. Bidding will start at the price noted next to each item. It could stop there, and some lucky Juggalo could walk away with a steal. If more than one person wants the item, then the bidding war ensues until the auctioneer calls, "Going once... going twice... sold to the big baller with the heavy cheddar!"

The starting bids are always low compared to the worth of the items so that everybody, no matter how strapped for cash, has a shot. And just like last year, one of the Juggalos who wins an auction will walk away with 25% of the total proceeds from the auction! At the Gathering 2000 one lucky bastard got a quick two grand – way more than enough to pay for the auction he won and spring for snacks for all his crew.

ITEM #3 – HALLOWICKED BOX SET /2 HALLOWICKED PASSES STARTING BID – \$20 RATING –EXTREMELY RARE

Only 2000 made, the Hallowicked Box Set is Psychopathic Records' first. Nearly all were given away at the two sold out shows on Devil's Night and Halloween 2000. Due to the chaos and near riot that broke out after the show, several people did not claim boxes. Held for six months, Psychopathic decided these few boxes should be in Juggalos' hands, not the warehouse. So here it is, a complete, intact Hallowicked Box Set, featuring special editions of Bizzar, Bizaar, and Freekshow, the Hallowicked 2000 compilation CD, limited edition Hallowicked 2000 T-shirt, special Hallowicked sticker, and certificate of authenticity. Add to this what no one attending the show got: two authentic Hallowicked backstage passes - now that's a complete collection!

ITEM #4 - POWERFUL POSTERS STARTING BID - \$5 RATING - EXTREMELY RARE

Though it's seen better days, the backdrop is still plenty powerful enough to transform an entire room into a reflection of the Dark Carnival.

ITEM #11 - BIGGER THAN LIFE ICP STARTING BID - \$20 RATING - UNIQUE

This unique foam core poster of Violent J and Shaggy 2-Dope dwarfs even life-size stand-ups. At 7 ½ feet by nearly 4 feet, you'd better clear some wall space! You can tell by their dreadlocks that they come from another era entirely.

This item contains nothing short of 20 unique pages full of photo shoot proofs of ICP and Twiztid. This is the physical result of many individual photo shoots, primarily from the Amazing Jeckel Brothers era, costing ten of thousands of dollars. Each page of shots is totally unique and irreplaceable. Many of these pictures

have been made into posters, T-shirts, and other merchandise, or used in various publications. Note the grease pen marks made by ICP, Alex Abbiss, and other Psychopathic Dons to indicate the pictures they liked.

Most Juggalos know that for some shows and events Psychopathic Records produces not only back stage passes to distinguish employees, but Crew T-shirts as well. These are typically worn for a night, then carefully stored away, perhaps to make an appearance at the Big Ballers X-Mas Party, or some other special event. Well, Psychopathic Records' employees got together and decided that it was time to give away seven of their most prized possessions:

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The nightlife of Toledo is out there, you only have to know where to look. Here are some late-night areas that may be worthy of checking out. Each of these places are open Friday and Saturday until 2am, if not later, so peep some of this flavor if you're wandering the streets at night with nothing to do. Look on the map provided on the right for the general location of each of these places but you may need a detailed street map to avoid getting lost. Keep in mind that we at Psychopathic have compiled this list based on some secondhand knowledge, since none of us are from Toledo, so we cannot guarantee how Juggalo-friendly any of these places are. Whether or not a place is phat is really a hit-or-miss gamble.

- #1) Banana Joes (18+) 505 Jefferson Ave. (419) 418–2000. This party bar/club is in walking distance of the SeaGate Centre, and features all the radio hits from the '70s through the '00s. It is where the model babes chill, and the party ninjas get their mack on. This is a neden heaven for the weary traveler, but you have to have mad game to actually to pull a hottie, 'cause they tend to be upper class.
- #2) Club Bijuo (18+) 29 North Superior (419) 243–4446. This club is perhaps the best club that Toledo has to offer. It features two floors bumping house and techno music, so you can dance and drink till the party, your bank, or your heart, stops. It also features young, stacked, tight-clothed freaks that won't give you the time of day... (we threw that in 'cause that's a given at any club).
- #3) Main Event 137 Main St. (419) 693–5300. If live band music is your flavor, then check out this club that isn't always all ages, but is catering specifically to the young Juggalos who are in town. This club is dark, shady, and loud. It may be just the place to find a sewer skank chillin' in between the walls, to capture and take back to the hotel.
- #4) Platinum Showgirls (18+) 5801 Telegraph Rd. (419) 476–6640. The hottest, sexiest, stacked-beyond-belief dancers can be found within the steamy walls of this erotic club, open till 5am. There is a small bar attached that offers smooth liquid pleasures to guzzle while you get your peep on. Bring the dollas, and don't bother to holla, 'cause to walk away with one of these sex goddesses would take mack abilities on par with Dolimite's.
- **#5)** Scarlet's (18+) 5765 Telegraph Rd. (419) 476–9611. Being right next door to Platinum Showgirls, together they make this area the hot spot to be. This club open till 5am, does not serve alcohol, but does have full nudity! The girls tend to be voluptuous and sexy, and will fulfill all your rated-R

fantasies, as long as the dollars keep going into their greedy hands.

- **#6) Déjà Vu** (18+) 135 S. Byrne Rd. (419) 531–0329. Open till 4am, this non-alcoholic, fully-nude strip club is the place to be to "get a feel" for all Toledo has to offer. This club is nationally renown to provide lusty entertainment at the highest level of sleazy perfection.
- #7) Detroit Debatably, one of the freshest hooks of Toledo is its location, meaning its proximity to other fresh cities. Just an hour drive and you're in for some helly flavor. Take I-75 north until you start to see the decrepit buildings, fires burning, and crackhead-lined streets of Detroit, home of ICP, Twiztid, and Blaze. Here you will find everything from its many casinos, tittie bars, haunted buildings, seedy after-hour clubs, and so much more. The power of the Dark Carnival resides heavily here for all to feel.
- #8) Toledo Sports Center Bowling 1516 Starr (419) 693–0687 This is the place for all those who love to bowl. Plenty of lanes are available, and it features Glow Bowling, so check it out.
- #9) University Lanes 2567 W. Bancroft St. (419) 531–2821 The perfect place to roll a ball so that it strikes some pins. How could you go wrong with bowling? It's the perfect way to kill some time when waiting for the next day of the Gathering.
- **#10)** Big Boys 175 S. Summit St. (419) 244–3093 Open 24 hours a day, and only a short walk from the SeaGate Centre, you may be one of the many who will make this restaurant a 2nd home. Burgers, salads, or breakfast snacks, it's all here and it's all good. This place definitely has fat kid love.
- #11) Denny's 1122 Buck Rd., Rossford (419) 666–4774 What more needs to be said about this classic 24 hours a day restaurant? It's perhaps the biggest after club hangout. What better place to try to pick up on, or mess with, some half-drunk and half-drugged people, while you enjoy a late-night snack?
- #12) Yoko Spa (23 +) 10095 Airport Hwy. (419) 865–9699 For those with an abundant cash flow, may we suggest this highly pleasurable Oriental Heath Spa? Some highlights to a visit to this sensual spa include massages, saunas, body shampoos, as well as other possible benefits for some extra cash. Don't ask us why you have to be 23 years old to get-in, just rest assured that if you fit the age requirements you won't be disappointed.
